- Part 2: Grown-ups, please ask the child a few of the included questions/prompts.

PART 1 SCRIPT:

What is art...let me think ...

Art means a really beautiful way of letting out your feelings.

There's no rules in art. There's no such thing as wrong.

PART 2 PROMPTS: (Grown-ups, please spend a minute having a chat with the child using these prompts or your own questions about their interest in art. No need to rehearse answers. We just want to get a sense of their natural personality and conversational voice - and their real thoughts!!!)

- How would you describe what art is? (Like maybe, if you were explaining it to an alien.)
- What types of art do you like to make? (drawing, dancing, acting, music, etc). List them all!
- What's your favorite thing about making art? Why?
- Do you get excited to share a painting, a dance, a creation...with someone else? Why?
- Do you ever get nervous about sharing something? Why?
- Repeat and finish this statement: "A world without art would feel_____"
