How do 5x5 and TAG work?

Teachers and school administrators apply through the FFTA online grant portal. Applications should be submitted by your school's 5x5/TAG liaison. If you do not know who your school's liaison is, or a new liaison is needed, please check with your principal, or contact grants@fundforthearts.org. All applications must have principal approval before they are submitted.

Who is eligible to apply for 5x5 and TAG?

K-12 teachers and administrators in Bullitt, Jefferson, Oldham, and Shelby counties in Kentucky; and Clark, Floyd, and Harrison counties in Indiana.


Tips for Applicants:

- Use the **At-A-Glance** beginning on page six to search by discipline, academic content connections, or grade level to find the program best suited for your classroom.
- Buses and transportation are not included in the Program and Student/Ticket Costs for Field Trips. Your school is responsible for getting students to and from the off-site program. If you need additional funds to cover this expense, complete the "Bus Cost" section on the Funding Request page of the application. FFTA pays schools directly for awarded bus funds.
- If the program you are requesting requires **additional mileage**, be sure to add it to your funding request. You may have to contact the arts program provider to confirm additional mileage before requesting the program.
- A Contact Sheet with all participating arts program provider contact information has been provided beginning on page four. Please contact the arts program provider directly with program-specific questions.
- **Program descriptions** are listed alphabetically by arts program provider name in two sections: In-Person (pages 12-65) and Virtual only (pages 66-69).
- If your school is applying for more than one program, we recommend no more than **six program applications per school.** Please complete one application per requested program (i.e. a program for multiple classes can be applied for on one application as long as the program is the same).
